

Organizational Club Leaders Kick-Off Sept 18 6:30pm. All Organizational Club Leaders must attend this training or schedule a make-up date with Cristy. We will discuss end of year wrap-up and new year information, risk management, and some basic 4-H policy reminders. **Achievement Night** – We are waiting for confirmation on dates from Salem Fire Hall, but this will be on a Friday evening in November. More information to follow! A few general reminders: ❖ You must be enrolled by Jan 1! Go to http://virginia.4honline.com to enroll or re-enroll. ❖ You must attend a minimum of 6 club meetings in order to maintain your active status as a 4-H member and be eligible to show in 4-H events and shows. ❖ You must participate in a community service within your club. Generally each club provides multiple opportunities, but if you are unable to participate in a community service, please discuss alternative plans with your club leader. Livestock members must be enrolled in the project club and meet all of the club requirements the first year you show that species of animal (for example if you are showing hogs for the first time you MUST enroll in the swine club). After you have successfully completed one year of a project you may choose to join another club and still show the original project, but you must meet all the requirements of membership in a minimum of one club. For example if you were in the swine club last year and showed hogs, this year you may join the sheep club and show sheep and hogs – but you must meet all of the requirements of the sheep club in order to maintain your enrollment status!
